## My Concerns:

### 1. Revenue:

- a. We need to explore new opportunities to ensure long-term sustainability for our tribe.
- b. Proactive Change in Operations, we must streamline our operations to improve efficiency across all departments and enterprises that generate revenue for the tribes.
- c. Prioritize and Strengthen Infrastructure: For example, CRIT Farms, Bluewater Casino, & Both Running Man gas stations.
- d. Create programs & positions that would allow our graduates to return to the Tribes & help grow the ability of the tribes to compete for sustainable revenue.

### 2. LAW & ORDER:

- a. Why do our officers leave CRIT PD after all the money & time invested in them? **CRIT doesn't offer State Retirement Fund.**
- b. Man Power, we need our protection. We need our own police force.

### 3. Housing:

- a. We need a better plan to handle this MAJOR ISSUE and FAST.
- b. Affordability

### 4. WATER:

- a. Water is an ongoing concern, and we need to develop a comprehensive plan to manage and protect for the future.
- b. Make sure we get the best possible deal in favor of the TRIBES
