5) Have infrastructure to establish a work force to repair our roads, wild fire crews, housing incentives

6) Erase the mindset with honesty - that the Tribal Government is not self serving. There is more to expansion and. This is only the tip of the iceberg.

7) Expand communication and technology concrete decisions, problem solving vehicle includes the Tribal Council and managers, to be successful

8) Managing conflicts
