**Part 1. Answers to the Questions discussed at the Pre-Bid Meeting held  
on May 05, 2026, at 12:00pm AZ.**

**Question 1: Do GC's need to be licensed in both CA and AZ?** The project is fully in the state of California. Contractor shall adhere to applicable licenses as required by the state to perform work in the public right-of-way.

**Question 2: Who is responsible for gathering approvals for service lines to the homes?** As indicated in the Construction Specifications, page 44, “The Contractor shall work with the CRIT broadband operator and be responsible for obtaining written permission from the home-owner prior to installing the NID at the premise point. If the homeowner chooses to not have the NID installed at the premise point, then the Contractor shall solicit concurrence from the Engineer to eliminate the need to install the drop cable and NID to the premise.”

**Question 3: Is there TERO tax on the bid?** Yes. As outlined in the Tribal Employment Rights Labor Code Amendments, Section 1-402. Collection of Fees: “The Director shall be responsible for collecting assessed Employment Rights’ fees pursuant to regulations adopted by the Commission. Said fees shall be made payable to credited as follows: three (3%) percent of the total fees collected shall be placed in the CRIT general fund and one-half (1/2%) percent of the total fees collected shall be expended by the TERO

Department and Commission to carry out the purposes of this Code subject to the annual budget process.”

## **Part 2. Revisions to the Bid Opening Location**

The bid opening location shall take place at the **Bluewater Resort and Casino in Parker Arizona**. The meeting room is the **Navajo room**. The address of the casino is 11300 Resort Dr, Parker, AZ 85344.

## **Part 3. Revisions to the Submittal Date**

The bid due date and bid opening date have been changed to Thursday **May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2026 by 1:00 PM Arizona time**.
